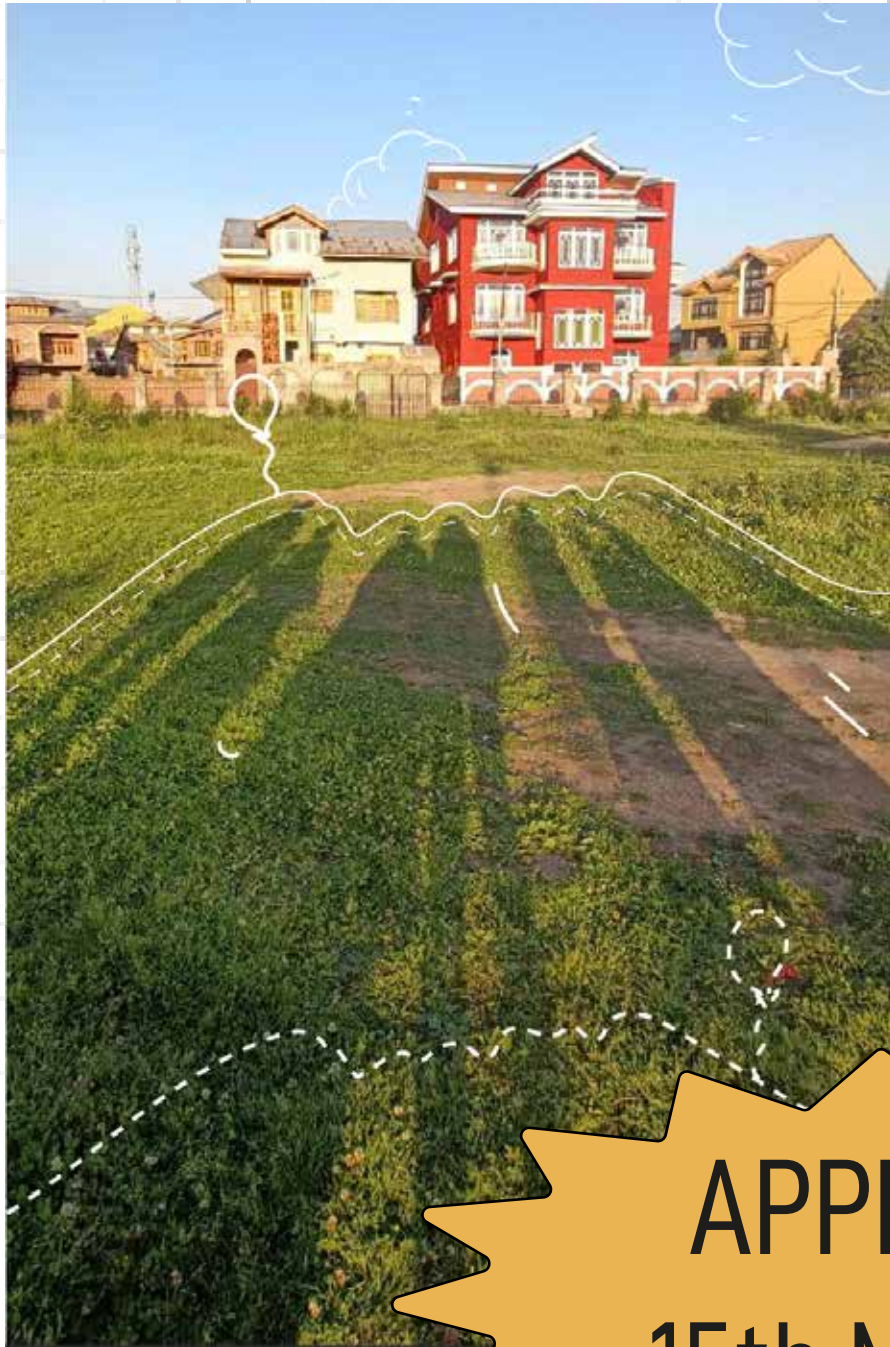

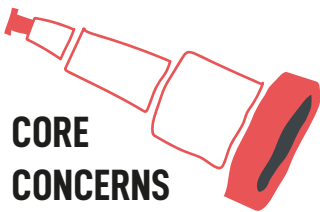

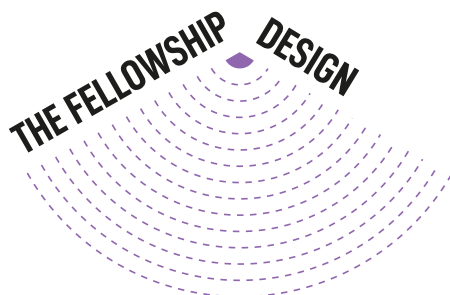


Inefficient framework of emotional well-being | Hazy foresight |

self-care, student support, design thinking, community building



Fellowship Duration: January 2027 - December 2028

Remuneration: Rs. 20,000/month + accommodation

Application Round 1: Till March 31

Application Round 2: Till May 15

July/August/September

announcement:** November 15
